"Prehistoric Footprints"

Jaskinia Wierchowska (The Wierchowska Cave)

It was the first cave in Europe to be a tourist attraction, with over 700 meters in length, interesting rock formations, fossil remains of prehistoric animals (bear, lion, hyena and reindeer), and even the most poisonous spider in Poland, the meta menardi. In 1997, an enormous piece of rock broke off above the cave and blocked the main entrance. It was the largest phenomena of this kind in the Cracow-Częstochowa region in the last century.
